Materials

- Worsted weight yarn (approximately 100 yards for each kitchen towel and 50 yards for each dishcloth)
- Size 8 knitting needles
- Tapestry needle

Abbreviations

- CO: Cast on

- K: Knit
- P: Purl
- BO: Bind off

Instructions

Kitchen Towels

1. CO 50 stitches.
2. K every row until the towel measures approximately 12 inches in length.
3. BO all stitches.

Dishcloths

1. CO 25 stitches.
2. K every row until the dishcloth measures approximately 8 inches in length.
3. BO all stitches.

Finishing

Once you have finished knitting your kitchen towels and dishcloths, you can finish them by weaving in the loose ends and blocking them. Blocking helps to even out the stitches and give your items a more polished look.

To block your kitchen towels and dishcloths, simply lay them flat on a towel and pin them out. Let them dry completely before using them.

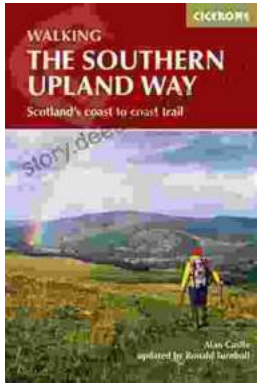


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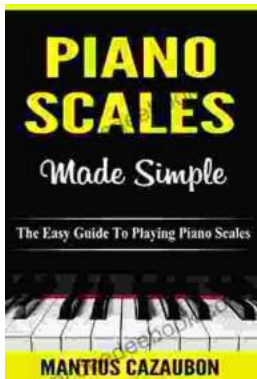
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
