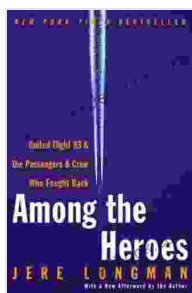


# United Flight 93 and the Passengers and Crew Who Fought Back: A Story of Courage and Resilience

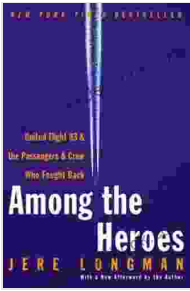

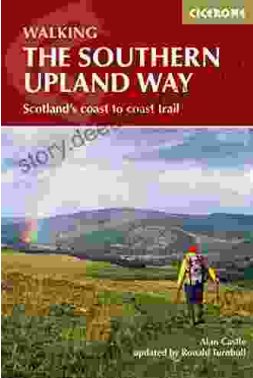

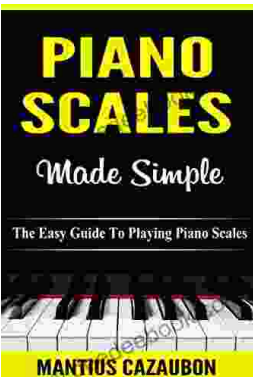
